#### A Table With A Hole

We love to use British, and particularly as we live in Wales, Welsh natively grown hardwoods for our work - and this little oak table is no exception. Many furniture-makers look for uniformity and regularity in their timber, but we do like to try to capture the real essence and character of the trees themselves and so we often deliberately choose wood with plenty of knots, burrs and grain – we actually value the 'imperfections' for adding to the personality of the piece! This coffee table uses our favourite dark cat's paw oak and is densely covered in natural burry patterns. Where a knot of the wood has fallen out, we have simply incorporated....the hole! You might either love it....or hate it, for going against the rules of good craftsmanship. But we rather like it and hope you will forgive us a little bit of furniture anarchy. The oak comes from a tree which grew in Llandeilo, Carmarthenshire.

#### A Classic Dark Welsh Oak Dining Table

Full of character, this dining table was crafted to show off the beautiful dark and grainy Welsh oak from a tree which once grew in the grounds of Picton Castle, one of Pembrokeshire's grand stately homes. The table's glorious deep colour stems from the fact that the timber has been seasoning slowly and naturally for nearly twenty years. As a dining table, it should last another two hundred! The table has contemporary styling, chunky wide-set legs and a slim rail for extra leg room. The top has been beautifully finished by hand to a high sheen. The table will comfortably seat six - eight people.

#### The Horse Chestnut Chest

Beautiful, panelled wooden chest, made very unusually with horse chestnut wood, from a tree which once grew in Saint Davids, Pembrokeshire. It is always sad to see a fallen tree like that, but we like to think that it can be helped to live on by turning it into a piece of furniture which may be treasured by future generations.

The grain of this horse chestnut is marvellously rippled and lustrous – Jake has carefully 'book-matched' it to accentuate the patterning. There is a deep cut 'V' shaped knot hole in one end which adds lots of character to the chest. The chestnut wood is a lovely pale colour (not conker-coloured!) – we have enhanced this with a slightly tinted wax on the panelling, which has turned it a warm golden honey.

The chest is rather elegant, yet still practical - ideal for clothes, blankets or linens. Decorative enough to place in the living room, bathroom or at the foot of the bed.

#### The Gunshot Table

A special, generously-sized console table crafted out of a single slab of rare Welsh elm, from Kidwelly, Carmarthenshire. The wood has beautiful long streaks of green, cream and pinky-brown. The table has elegant proportions with slender legs and a thoroughly useful under-shelf.

In the lower half of the right front leg there is a secret tiny detail; clear holes and metal stains from what we think were gunshot pellets, blasted into the trunk when it was alive, and now incorporated into the history of the tree. There is still one small piece of silver metal remaining on the inner side of the leg, which we have left as a little bit of archaeology in the furniture.

### **Contemporary Welsh Oak Coffee Table**

A blend of contemporary and classic, this solid little coffee table is made with stunning Welsh oak from Llandeilo, on the edge of The Brecon Beacons National Park.

The top, made from only one wide board which Jake has carefully split into two and opened up, ('book-matched'), is gloriously figured with striking, pale golden medullary rays and darker burrs.

The table has deep, similarly marked sides and modern tapered legs.

### **Classic Square Occasional Table**

Handmade with Welsh elm from near Kidwelly Castle, Carmarthenshire.

The grain is full of beautiful swirling patterns and there is a lovely natural heart upon the lower shelf.

#### **Tall Oak Cabinet**

Handsome, traditional cabinet-cupboard, crafted in Welsh oak, from Carmarthenshire. The combination of design and timber selection gives this piece of furniture a special character and feel. The wood we have chosen is rich, dark and unusually well figured with ripples and 'cat's paw' marks – we've left the quirks, burrs and even small knot holes as features. It makes a most attractive piece of furniture. The door-panels are of solid oak, carefully 'book-matched' to showcase the grain. It sits on long legs and has a useful slatted under-shelf. The cabinet is lockable.

This would make a splendid drinks cabinet....or perhaps books...blankets...china...treasures...?

# **Modern Retro Style Welsh Cherry Coffee Table**

This is a smart, modern style coffee table with a stylish cross legged design. The wood we have used is an unusual, light Welsh cherry wood, full of lustrous pinks and greens in the grain, which really catch the light. The colours will only become richer as the table ages. The top of the table feels as smooth as silk and is a joy to touch.

## **Wavy-Edged Welsh Yew Console Table**

An eye-catching and unique Pembrokeshire yew wood console. This beautiful side table features the paler sapwood of the wavy edges, contrasting with the rich, amber coloured heartwood. Although intensely durable, the yew wood feels as smooth as silk to touch. Interestingly, Prime Minister David Cameron thought so too, when we talked to him and showed him the table, at a special reception hosted by Number 10 at the Celtic Manor, to thank suppliers of Welsh-made products to the NATO Summit Wales 2014.

A classic circular occasional table, reminiscent of the furniture of the eighteenth century. This pretty and useful little table is crafted from prime dark Carmarthenshire oak and has four splayed legs emerging from the pedestal, which has been hand turned on our lathe.

#### Welsh Lacewood Drop-Leaf Dining Table

Created with a certain vintage styling, this is a practical and beautiful drop-leaf table, made from marvellously rare and patterned Welsh lacewood, which is also known as the wood of the London Plane Tree - common in the capital, but only grown as an ornamental tree here in West Wales.

Otherwise called a gate-legged or Pembroke table, this style of extendable table is particularly versatile and can be opened or closed to become a full-sized dining table, a square table for four, or a slim console table. If you have surprise extra guests, simply open up the table et voila, dinner for six.

Because of the quirky character of this spalted wood, this table almost has a 'vintage' feel about it and there is a small curve in the boards, which has become a pleasing feature of the piece.

### **The Humbug Table**

Sweet little coffee table, very modern and striped! A striking and chic piece, with a nod in style to the furniture of the late 50s and 60s. The sharp lines are created using pale honey-coloured maple wood, alternating with pieces of rich, dark sapele mahogany (sustainably grown).

This table is one of the five pieces of Uniqueworks furniture which were particularly selected by Number 10, to help represent the craftsmanship of Wales, to the assembled world leaders at the NATO Summit Wales 2014. The table was showcased in the Leaders VIP Lounge at Celtic Manor during the Summit.

An appealing little desk, made in Welsh oak. The single wide drawer has proper hand-cut dovetail joints. The legs are slender and mirror the symmetry in the grain.

#### Welsh Beech Kitchen Table

The wood for this table came from a large beech tree that grew near Carmarthen. We seasoned and air-dried the planks carefully for two and a half years before creating this pretty little table. A high gloss polish reveals the beautiful semi-spalted grain and protects the table from wear and tear.

Beech wood is an excellent choice for kitchen and dining furniture as it is hard-wearing and also benefits from having natural antibacterial and anti-fungal properties.
